## THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (COTON BRIDGE, COTON ROAD, PARISH OF NETHER WHITACRE) (WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2024

The Warwickshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -

## 1. In this Order:

"Maximum Gross Weight" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

"Authorised Vehicle" means an unladen vehicle authorised by the Council in writing to proceed across Coton Bridge for the sole purpose of gaining access to or egress from the industrial park known as "The Cedars".

- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle the Maximum Gross Weight of which exceeds 18 tonnes to proceed in that length of Coton Road which is carried by Coton Bridge over the River Tame between Marston and Whitacre Heath.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to an Authorised Vehicle which is unladen.
- 4. The Warwickshire County Council (Coton Bridge, Coton Road, Parish of Nether Whitacre) (Weight Restriction) Order 2022 is hereby revoked.
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on the Tenth day of November Two thousand and twenty-four and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Coton Bridge, Coton Road, Parish of Nether Whitacre) (Weight Restriction) Order 2024.
