**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (COTON BRIDGE, COTON ROAD, PARISH OF NETHER WHITACRE) (WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2024**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of an Experimental Order imposing an 18-tonne maximum gross weight limit restriction on the length of road described in the Schedule below, with an exemption for empty vehicles authorised in writing by the Council to access “The Cedars”.

The Order commences on 10 November 2024.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of the Experimental Order and a copy of an Order to be revoked, a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, are available for inspection at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick and online at [www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20206/north-warwickshireborough](http://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20206/north-warwickshireborough)

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
