Proposed Raised Road Hump

STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1.0 Warwickshire County Council is proposing to install a raised road hump feature. measuring approximately 5.5 metres (length) x 6.2 metres (Width) x 0.75 metres (height) on Ullenhall Lane West of Forde Hall Lane, Ullenhall.
- 1.1 The scheme is being put forward by Cllr Ian Shenton and supported by Ullenhall Parish Council to improve road safety for all vulnerable road users. This would be installed at the gateway to the new 20 mph speed limit which has been introduced as part of the Ullenhall Village Speed Limit scheme .
- 1.2 . The scheme will involve the installation of a raised road hump feature 75mm in height to give vertical deflection, full width of the road 6.24m, and 5.5m in length. The raised road hump is positioned within the Give & Take at the 20mph speed limit change, this will help improve the environment for residents, pedestrians, and cyclists by restricting vehicle speeds and improving road. safety.
- **1.3** The location of the raised table is set out in schedule 1 and detailed on Drawing No. PTR023/014/02.
