**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BOROUGH OF RUGBY) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES
AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO. 9) ORDER 2025**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough Of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places And Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

SCHEDULE

Proposed Limited Waiting

(Mon to Sat between 8am and 8pm – Waiting Limited to 2 hours, no return within 4 hours)
(Except for Zone R2 Permit Holders)

Cambridge Street, Rugby

East side, from a point 22 metres north of its junction with Clifton Road, northwards for 18 metres
East side, from a point 51 metres north of its junction with Clifton Road, northwards for 25 metres
East side, from a point 88 metres north of its junction with Clifton Road, northwards for 19 metres
East side, from a point 118 metres north of its junction with Clifton Road, northwards for 135 metres
East side, from a point 260 metres north of its junction with Clifton Road, northwards for 60 metres
West side, from a point 24 metres north of its junction with Clifton Road, northwards for 38 metres
West side from a point 72 metres north of its junction with Clifton Road, northwards for 55 metres
West side from a point 136 metres north of its junction with Clifton Road, northwards for 185 metres
West side from a point 326 metres north of its junction with Clifton Road, northwards for 13 metres

Residents parking zone R2 eligibility

Cambridge Street (even numbers 2 to 102 inclusive, including numbers 1 to 6 Cambridge Court)"
