**(CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION D) ORDER 2024**

**1. BACKGROUND**

**1.1** This Order is proposed under a developer led scheme, using a Section 278 Agreement. This development includes up to 24 dwellings and a Medical Practice and has the planning reference number PAP/2019/0599.

**2. STATEMENT OF REASONS**

**2.1 Church Road**

It is proposed to:

- (i) Revoke part of the existing No Waiting Mon-Fri 8.30am-4.30pm (single yellow lines) on Church Road and replace with No Waiting At Any Time (double yellow lines).
- (ii) Introduce new No Waiting At Any Time (double yellow lines) on Church Road at the entrances to Hartshill Medical Practice and Hartshill School.

This is intended to prevent parking to provide unobstructed access to Hartshill Medical Practice and Hartshill School and improve visibility and road safety for all road users including pedestrians and cyclists along this section of road.

**3. SCHEDULE**

**3.1 No Waiting At Any Time**

**Church Road**

- (i) North-west side, from a point 50 metres north-east of its junction with Hayes Road, north-eastwards for 64 metres.
- (ii) South-east side, from a point 43 metres north-east of its junction with Victoria Road north-eastwards to the entrance to Hartshill School.
- (iii) South-east side, from the centreline of the entrance to Hartshill School north-eastwards for 13 metres.

**Church Road – entrance to Hartshill Medical Practice**

Both sides, from its junction with Church Road, north-westwards for 3 metres.

**Church Road – entrance to Hartshill School**

Both sides, from its junction with Church Road, south-eastwards for 8 metres.

**4. EXISTING ORDERS TO BE VARIED**

**4.1** The Warwickshire County Council (Borough of North Warwickshire) (Waiting Restrictions and On Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2017.
