-1 x Road Hump in the form of a raised junction hump, incorporating a priority crossing for pedestrians and cyclists, pursuant to Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, upon the lengths of road as described in Schedule 1 below on Glasshouse Lane/Heyville Croft, Kenilworth;

and

-a segregated cycle track, for use by cyclists only, adjacent to the footway/relocated footway/carriageway, pursuant to Section 65 and 66 of the Highways Act 1980 upon the lengths of road as described in Schedule 2 below on Glasshouse Lane, Kenilworth.

<u>Proposed Road Hump incorporating a priority crossing for pedestrians and cyclists - Heyville Croft – Junction with Glasshouse Lane, Kenilworth</u>

Road Hump dimension: 9.91 m (width) x 8.6 m (length) x 75 mm (height).

Proposed Segregated Cycle Track- Glasshouse Lane, Kenilworth

From a point 49.5 metres southwest of its junction with Heyville Croft for a distance of 110 metres in a north-easterly direction (north-east bound side of the carriageway- as is to be realigned).
