ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A446 LICHFIELD ROAD/THE BELFRY, WISHAW) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) ORDER 2025

1. BACKGROUND

1.1 This Order is proposed under a developer led scheme, using a Section 278 Agreement for some minor junction improvements.

2. STATEMENT OF REASONS

2.1 A446 Lichfield Road/The Belfry

It is proposed to prohibit the right turn manoeuvre for all vehicles exiting The Belfry onto A446 Lichfield Road. The junction at Ryefield Lane will also be modified for the purpose of limiting vehicle turning and access as shown on the plan attached labelled BB0077-WDA-EW-XX-DR-H-02-1203 Rev P3 and as described in the below Schedule.

The aim of this scheme is to mitigate the risk of vehicle collisions at this location due to a number of personal injury collisions at this junction, thereby improving road safety and improving the environment for all road users. Furthermore, avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

The scheme will involve the use of regulatory signs to reinforce the new restrictions, in full compliance with Traffic Sign Regulations and General Directions (TSRGD) 2016.

3 SCHEDULE

3.1 Prohibition of Right Turn

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle from turning right from the access road of The Belfry onto the A446 Lichfield Road, Wishaw.

4 PRIORITY

a. High.
