**1. BACKGROUND**

1.1 This Order is proposed under a developer led scheme, as part of a Section 278 Agreement on land adjacent to Station Road. This development includes up to 100 dwellings with direct access to the development onto Station Road.

**2. STATEMENT OF REASONS**

**2.1 Station Road, High Street and Wharf Road**

2.2 It is proposed to reduce the current National Speed Limit (60mph) to a 40mph speed limit, on Station Road and Wharf Road in Fenny Compton, due to the construction of a new development of up to 100 properties. A reduced speed limit would improve road safety and improve the environment for all road users. The scheme will involve the use of speed limit signage to reinforce the new limit.

It is also proposed to vary the existing 30mph Speed Limit Order on High Street and Station Road, Fenny Compton, to correct an administrative error, as described in the Schedule below.

**3. SCHEDULE**

**3.1 40mph Speed Limit**

**1. Station Road, Fenny Compton**

From a point 400 metres north-eastwards of its junction with High Street, for its entire length, to its junction with Wharf Road.

**2. Wharf Road, Fenny Compton**

From its junction with Station Road, in a north easterly direction for its entire length, to its junction with the A423 and including the entire length of Wharf Road which terminates at the Oxford Canal Walk Bridge.

### **3.2 30mph Speed Limit**

#### **1. High Street, Fenny Compton**

From a point 50 metres north-east of its junction with Cotters Croft in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Station Road.

#### **2. Station Road, Fenny Compton**

From its junction with High Street in an easterly and north-easterly direction for 400 metres.
