ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STATION ROAD & WHARF ROAD, FENNY COMPTON)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under section 84 the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Save as provided in Article 2 below, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road described in Schedule 1 to this Order.
2. The provisions of Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when such a vehicle is used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Station Road & Wharf Road, Fenny Compton) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2025" and shall come into operation on the 31st day of March Two Thousand and Twenty-Five.

SCHEDULE 1
(40 mph Speed Limit)

Station Road, Fenny Compton

From a point 400 metres north-eastwards of its junction with High Street, for its entire length, to its junction with Wharf Road.

Wharf Road, Fenny Compton

From its junction with Station Road, in a north easterly direction, for its entire length, to its junction with the A423 and including the entire length of Wharf Road which terminates at the Oxford Canal Walk Bridge.
