ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Warwickshire County Council (Moors Lane, Houlton)
(Prohibition of Vehicle Movements) Order 2025

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this Order “the Plan” means plan numbered PTRO21-016-01A and attached to this Order.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Moors Lane, Houlton shown with a dashed blue line on the Plan.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause a vehicle to proceed in the length of road to therein if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (1) in connection with the carrying out on that length of road of any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) the removal of obstructions to traffic
 - (ii) maintenance, improvement, repair or reconstruction work, and the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in that length of road of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984
 - (2) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes; or
 - (3) in the service of a local authority or a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker of the environment agency in pursuance of statutory powers or duties which are being undertaken on that length of road.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the _____ day of _____ Two thousand and twenty five and may be cited as “The Warwickshire County Council (Moors Lane, Houlton) (Prohibition of Vehicle Movements) Order 2025”.
