THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A446 LICHFIELD ROAD/THE BELFRY, WISHAW) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) ORDER 2025

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to make a right hand turn from the access road of The Belfry onto the A446 Lichfield Road, Wishaw.
- 2. The provisions of Article 1 above shall not apply to a vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire and rescue, police or ambulance purposes, when such a vehicle is responding to an emergency call and displaying a blue flashing light, if the observance of that Article would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.
- 3. The Order shall come into operation on the 25th day of June Two thousand and twenty-five and may be cited as 'The Warwickshire County Council (A446 Lichfield Road/The Belfry, Wishaw) (Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 2025.
