ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(A446 LICHFIELD ROAD/THE BELFRY, WISHAW)
(PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) ORDER 2025

Warwickshire County Council have made the above named Order under the road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit right turning movements as described in the Schedule below. The Public Notice was advertised 11th April and was due to commence on the 14th April 2025, however the Order was not made on this date and will now commence on 25th June 2025.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose."

SCHEDULE

Prohibition of Right Turn

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle from turning right from the access road of The Belfry onto the A446 Lichfield Road, Wishaw.
