ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OLD GATED ROAD, CHESTERTON)
(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2025

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit motor vehicles from using that length of Old Gated Road, Chesterton which is described in the Schedule below. The Order commences on Monday 7 July 2025.

The Order has been made as modified to include an exemption for emergency services vehicles.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE

Old Gated Road, Chesterton

From a point 570 metres north of its junction with B4100 Chesterton Hill/Banbury Hill, northwards for a distance of 5 metres.
