THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OLD GATED ROAD, CHESTERTON) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2025

Warwickshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 1 and 2 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. In this Order:-
 - 'motor vehicle' shall have the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 below, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in that length of Old Gated Road, Chesterton as described in the Schedule below.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road referred to therein if the motor vehicle is being used for fire and rescue, police or ambulance purposes.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on the Seventh day of July Two thousand and twenty-five and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Old Gated Road, Chesterton) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 2025".

SCHEDULE

Old Gated Road, Chesterton

From a point 570 metres north of its junction with B4100 Chesterton Hill/Banbury Hill, northwards for a distance of 5 metres.
