TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C72 LOXLEY ROAD, STAPLE HILL, WELLESBOURNE ROAD, LOXLEY

Warwickshire County Council **proposes to make** a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

Effect of Order	C72 Loxley Road, Staple Hill, Wellesbourne Road, Loxley is closed to vehicular traffic between its junction with Horseshoe Crescent and Redhill Road.
Reason for Order	To safely enable carriageway resurfacing and associated works. Road closed 0900 - 1530 hrs, Weekdays only.
Order Effective from: 15 September 2025 for up to 18 months or until works are completed, whichever is sooner.	
Anticipated Completion Date: 24 September 2025	
Access & Diversion: An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Wellesbourne Road, Stratford Road, Loxley Road, Alveston Hill, Loxley Road, B4086 (Tiddington Road, Main Street, Wellesbourne Road, Stratford Road), A429, Loxley Road and vice versa. Vehicular access & egress will be maintained where possible and safe to do so for businesses and residents only. Access/egress to/from Loxley Lane via B4086 Stratford Road whilst works are in progress.
