# ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

# THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHURCH STREET AND WHEAT STREET, NUNEATON) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2004

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- Save as provided in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a non-mechanically propelled vehicle being pushed by a pedestrian to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause a vehicle to proceed in the length of road to therein if the vehicle is being used:-
  - (1) In connection with the carrying out on that length of road of any of the following operations, namely:-
    - (i) the removal of obstructions to traffic
    - (ii) maintenance, improvement, repair or reconstruction work, and
    - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in that length of road of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
  - (2) For fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes; or
  - (3) in the service of a local authority or a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker of the environment agency in pursuance of statutory powers or duties which are being undertaken on that length of road.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 24<sup>th</sup> of May 2004 and may be cited as 'The Warwickshire County Council (Church Street and Wheat Street Nuneaton) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2004.

#### SCHEDULE Prohibition of Driving 24 hours daily

## Church Street, Nuneaton

From its junction with Mill Street to its junction with Bridge Street, a distance of 59 metres.

# Wheat Street, Nuneaton (West Side)

From its junction with Vicarage Street on its western side, heading west towards Bondgate for a distance of 10 metres.
