PROPOSED ROAD HUMPS (RAISED JUNCTION) WHEAT STREET / JUSTICE WALK / BOND STREET

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 Warwickshire County Council are preparing to undertake major infrastructure works as part of the Transforming Nuneaton Highway Improvements programme.
- 1.2 The Transforming Nuneaton highway improvements programme is a suite of projects that will support development to Nuneaton town centre and the wider borough.
- 1.3 It will unlock development to support the wider Transforming Nuneaton programme, help to reduce and improve the existing Air Quality Management Areas (AQMAs), enhance existing cycling infrastructure, along with creating new infrastructure, therefore encouraging more sustainable travel and relieve existing localised pinch points and congestion.

2. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 2.1 Warwickshire County Council is proposing, pursuant to Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to install a road hump in the form of a raised junction at the junction of Wheat Street / Justice Walk / Bond Street, Nuneaton.
- 2.2 The dimensions of the raised junction/road hump and location of the raised junction/road hump is as described in schedule below.
- 2.3 The raised junction/road hump is for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic, and for improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs for pedestrians and cyclists.

3. SCHEDULE

3.1 Introduction of Road Hump (Raised Junction)

Located on Wheat Street, at its junctions with Justice Walk and Bond Gate.

Road Hump dimension: 15.8 m (width) x 26m (length) x 75mm (height) with an area of approximately 287m².
