# THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (JUSTICE WALK AND WHEAT STREET, NUNEATON) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2014

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause any vehicle to proceed in in any of the lengths of road described in Colum 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specific in relation to that length of road in Column 2 of that Schedule.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 23 day of October Two Thousand and Fourteen and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Justice Walk and Wheat Street, Nuneaton) (One Way Traffic) Order 2014".
