ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF WARWICK) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION Q) ORDER 2025; and

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (D4090 CROSS STREET AND D4129 ST JOHNS SERVICE ROAD, WARWICK) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Orders, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to

- (i) vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (District of Warwick) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places And Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as described (by approximate measurements) in Schedule 1 below; and
- (ii) to introduce one way traffic flows as described in more detail in Schedule 2 below.

The Orders will commence on 1 October 2025.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in Schedule 1 below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Orders apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1

No Waiting At Any Time

Priory Road, Warwick

- (i) Northern side from its junction with A429 St Johns, westwards for 24.8 metres.
- (ii) Southern side from its junction with Smith Street, westwards for 21.9 metres.

St Johns (A429), Warwick

- (i) Northern side from its junction with Priory Road, north-eastwards for 30.9 metres.
- (ii) Southern side from its junction with St Nicholas Church Street, north-eastwards for 10.3 metres.

St Johns (D4129 Service Road), Warwick

Eastern side - from a point 63 metres south of its junction with The Paddocks, south-westwards for 8 metres.

St Nicholas Church Street, Warwick

- (i) Eastern side from its junction with A429 St Johns, southwards for 27.5 metres.
- (ii) Western side from its junction with A429 St Johns, southwards for 22.8 metres.

Smith Street, Warwick

- (i) Northern side, from its junction with Priory Road, south-westwards for 25.2 metres.
- (ii) Southern side, from its junction with A429 St Johns, south-westwards for 22.9 metres.

<u>Limited Waiting - Mon-Sat 9am-5pm (1 Hour, No Return within 2 hours)</u>

St Johns (D4129 Service Road), Warwick

- (i) Two bays at its northern end from a point 7 metres north of its junction with The Paddocks, northward for 5 metres
- (ii) Eastern side from a point 10 metres south of its junction with The Paddocks, southward for 53 metres

Blue Badge Holders Only

St Johns (D4129 Service Road), Warwick

Eastern side - from a point 71 metres south of its junction with The Paddocks, south westward for 6.6 metres.

Loading Only

St Johns (D4129 Service Road), Warwick

Eastern side - from a point 77.6 metres south of its junction with The Paddocks, south-westward for 8.6 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

One Way Traffic Flows

D4090 Cross Street, Warwick - north-westerly traffic flow

From its junction with A429 Smith Street, north-westwards for a distance of 29 metres.

D4129 St Johns Service Road, Warwick - generally south-westerly traffic flow

From its junction with D4128 The Paddocks, in a generally south-westerly direction for a distance of 83 metres.
