THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF NUNEATON & BEDWORTH) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO. EV1) ORDER 2025

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 Following the installation of a number of electric vehicle (EV) charging points across Warwickshire these are now being formalised.

2. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 2.1 The proposals to formalise existing EV recharging bays, which are not currently enforceable, will provide clear delineation between bays available for use by any vehicles including those with internal combustion engines (ICE) and those for EV charging only; the provision of EV infrastructure having a potential beneficial impact on air quality as well as supporting the authority's Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Infrastructure Strategy by enhancing EV parking options.
- 2.2 In determining the need to provide parking places for EV vehicles, the Council has considered it necessary for the purpose of preventing congestion of traffic.
- 2.3 In certain locations adjacent parking restrictions will be adjusted provide consistent restrictions on-street for both ICE and EV vehicles, providing clear and straightforward messaging to motorists, and clarity for civil enforcement officers.

3. SCHEDULE

Coton Road, Nuneaton (west side)

Electric Vehicles Only Limited Wait 2 Hours No Return 4 Hours

- (i) from a point 59 metres north of its junction with the A444 island, northward for 6.5 metres (2 no. perpendicular bays)

Lutterworth Road, Attleborough

Electric Vehicles Only

- (i) from a point in line with the western property boundary of number 20, south-eastward for 11 metres (2 no. bays)

4. Existing Order to be varied.

- 4.1 The Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Nuneaton and Bedworth) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017
