	'motor vehicle' shall have the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act.	
2.	Save as provided in Article 3 below, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in that length of Crewe Lane, Kenilworth as described in the Schedule below.	
3.	Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road referred to therein if the motor vehicle is being used for fire and rescue, police or ambulance purposes.	
4.	This Order shall come into operation on the day of Two thousand and twenty-six and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Crewe Lane, Kenilworth) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 2026".
