**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CREWE LANE, KENILWORTH)
(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026; AND**

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CREWE LANE, KENILWORTH)
(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2026**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Orders, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit motor vehicles from using that length of Crewe Lane, Kenilworth which is described in Schedule 1 below, and to impose a 30 mph speed limit on those lengths of Crewe Lane, Kenilworth which are described in Schedule 2 below.

The proposed prohibition of motor vehicles order would not prevent access for pedestrians and cyclists and an exemption is included for emergency services vehicles. Access to the Kenilworth Golf Club will be available from either side of the prohibition of motor vehicles. An alternative route for through traffic will be available via Knowle Hill, Dalehouse Lane, Stoneleigh Road, B4115 into Crewe Lane at its south eastern end and vice versa for the other direction.

SCHEDULE 1

(Proposed Prohibition of Motor Vehicles)

Crewe Lane, Kenilworth

From a point 492 metres east of its junction with Glasshouse Lane, eastwards for a distance of 99 metres

SCHEDULE 2

(Proposed 30 mph Speed Limit)

Crewe Lane, Kenilworth

- (i) From its junction with Glasshouse Lane, eastwards for a distance of 495 metres.
- (ii) From a point 112 metres south-east of its junction with Lancellotte Avenue, then in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 484 metres.
