**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A435 BIRMINGHAM ROAD,
COUGHTON, STUDLEY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026**

WHEREAS the Warwickshire County Council ("the Council") as traffic authority for A435 Birmingham Road, Coughton, Studley is satisfied that traffic on the said road should be restricted by virtue of works proposed to be executed thereon.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This order shall come into operation on 3 March 2026 and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (A435 Birmingham Road, Coughton, Studley) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2026".
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than an exempted vehicle to use A435 Birmingham Road, Coughton, Studley between the entrance to the Kings Court Hotel and the entrance to the Throckmorton Arms Public House for a period of 18 months commencing on 3 March 2026, or until the said works are completed, whichever is the earlier.
3. In this Order exempted vehicle means any vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
4. The provisions of Article 2 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs, as authorised by Section 64 of the said Act of 1984.
