AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION I) ORDER 2026**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to extend a no waiting at any time restriction on the A428 Lawford Road, Rugby by 10 metres, as described in more detail in the Schedule below.
