**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LUDDINGTON ROAD AND STANNELLS CLOSE, STRATFORD-UPON-AVON) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of its powers under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Save as provided in Article 2 below, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road described in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The provisions of Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when such a vehicle is used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. This Order may be cited as 'The Warwickshire County Council (Luddington Road And Stannells Close, Stratford-Upon-Avon) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2026' and shall come into operation on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March two thousand and twenty-six.

**SCHEDULE**

1. Luddington Road

From a point 5 metres south of the southern boundary line of the property known as Orchard House, then in a generally south westerly direction, to the south western boundary line of the property known as The Shire, a distance of 1240 metres.

2. Stannells Close

The whole length
