ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LUDDINGTON ROAD AND STANNELLS
CLOSE, STRATFORD-UPON-AVON)
(40MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION NO.268) ORDER 2026**
AND
**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LUDDINGTON ROAD AND STANNELLS
CLOSE, STRATFORD-UPON-AVON) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named variation Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will vary the Warwickshire County Council (Luddington Road and Stannells Close, Stratford-Upon-Avon) (40 M.P.H Speed Limit) Order 1993 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Principal Order'), as described in Schedule 1 below.

Warwickshire County Council further has made the above named Order to impose a 30mph speed limit, as described in Schedule 2 below.

A copy of the Orders, together with plans showing the lengths of road affected, a copy of the Principal Order and the statements of the Councils reasons for making the Orders, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick during usual opening hours and on Warwickshire County Council's website at <https://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20209/stratford-avon-district>

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Orders apply to the High Court for this purpose

SCHEDULE 1

1. In the Schedule to the Principal Order, item 1 is replaced with:

'Luddington Road, Stratford: From the south western boundary line of the property known as The Shire, to a point 13.83m east of the eastern property boundary for a distance of 539 metres.'

2. In the Schedule to the Principal Order, item 2 is revoked.

SCHEDULE 2

30mph speed limit:

1. Luddington Road

From a point 5 metres south of the southern boundary line of the property known as Orchard House, then in a generally south westerly direction, to the south western boundary line of the property known as The Shire, a distance of 1240 metres.

2. Stannells Close
