ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (COMBROOK, KINETON, PILLERTON PRIORS RATLEY AREA)
(PROHIBITION OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES OF OVER 7.5 TONNES) ORDER 1991

The Warwickshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this Order, "heavy commercial vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 138 of the Act;
2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause any heavy commercial vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause a heavy commercial vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of road referred to therein if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (1) for or in connection with the conveyance of goods to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to any of those lengths of road;
 - (2) for the purposes of agriculture on any land adjacent to any of those length of road or for or in connection with conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land;
 - (3) in connection with the carrying out on or on premises situated on or adjacent to any of those lengths of road of any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations,
 - (ii) the removal of obstructions to traffic,
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, and
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in, or in land adjacent to, any of those lengths of roads of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act, 1984;
 - (4) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (5) to proceed to or from any premises which are situated on or adjacent to any of those lengths of road and at which the vehicle is to be or has been, garaged, serviced or repaired;

- (6) in the service of a local authority or water undertaker or a sewerage undertaker or the National Rivers Authority pursuant to statutory powers or duties which are being undertaken on any of those lengths of road or on adjacent land or premises;
- (7) on that road for or in connection with the conveyance of goods for sale from the vehicle on any of those lengths of road;
- (8) in connection with a circus, fair, market or similar event to be held on, or in the vicinity of, any of those lengths of road; or
- (9) as mentioned in paragraphs (1) to (8) of this Article on any other road to which vehicular access can only be obtained via any road, or part of such road, mentioned in the Schedule to this Order.

4. The Council are satisfied that for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order run by restricting the use on those roads of heavy commercial vehicles, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act should not apply to this Order.

5. This Order shall come into operation on the 4th November, 1991 and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Combrook, Kineton, Pillerton Priors, Ratley Area) (Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles of Over 7.5 Tonnes) Order 1991".

SCHEDULE

1. The whole length of both Church Hill and Combrook Road in the Parish of Combrook.
2. The whole length of Warwick Road in the Parish of Pillerton Hersey.
3. The whole length of Kiblers Lane in the Parish of Pillerton Priors.
4. The whole length of Stamford Hall Lane in the Parish of Pillerton Priors.
5. That length of the B.4451 Southam - Kineton - Halford road which extends from its junction with the B.4086 Stratford-upon-Avon - Kineton - Warmington road in the Parish of Kineton to its junction with the A.422 Stratford-upon-Avon - Banbury road in the Parish of Pillerton Priors.
6. That length of the C.54 Wolford - Brailes - Little Kineton road which extends from its junction with the B.4451 Southam - Kineton - Halford road in the Parish of Kineton to its junction with the A.422 Stratford-upon-Avon - Banbury road in the Parish of Tysoe.
7. That length of the C.53 Honnington - Whatcote - Little Kineton road which extends from its junction with the C.54 Wolford - Brailes - Little Kineton road in the Parish of Kineton to its junction with the A.422 Stratford-upon-Avon - Banbury road in the Parish of Oxhill.

8. The whole length of the Radway Road (also known as Tysoe Fields Road) in the Parish of Tysoe.
9. The whole length of Tysoe Road in the Parishes of Radway and Tysoe.
10. The whole length of Farnborough Road in the Parish of Radway.
11. The whole length of Langdon Lane in the Parish of Radway.
12. That length of Sugarswell Lane in the Parish of Ratley and Upton which extends from its junction with the A.422 Stratford-upon-Avon - Banbury road to its junction with the B.4086 Stratford-upon-Avon - Kineton - Warmington road.
13. The whole length of both Old Road and Quarry Road in the Parish of Ratley and Upton.
14. That length of the unclassified road from Edge Hill to Upton which extends from its junction with Quarry Road to its junction with the A.422 Stratford-upon-Avon - Banbury road.


