**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BARBY ROAD AND ONLEY LANE, DUNCHURCH)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to reduce the existing national speed limit to 40 mph on those lengths of road which are described in the Schedule below.

From its junction with the B4426 Ashlawn Road, north-westwards for a distance of 88 metres.

Onley Lane, Dunchurch

From its junction with the B4426 Ashlawn Road, south-eastwards for a distance of 96 metres.
