**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A4189 WARWICK – HENLEY-IN-ARDEN –
REDDITCH ROAD AND LYE GREEN ROAD, CLAVERDON)
(30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (VARIATION NO. 2) ORDER 2026; AND**

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DISTRICT OF STRATFORD
ON AVON) (SPEED LIMIT) (A4189 CLAVERDON VARIATION NO. 3) ORDER 2026**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Orders, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to extend a 40 mph speed limit, replacing a section of existing 50 mph speed limit, on the A4189 Station Road, Claverdon. The proposed new extent of 40 mph speed limit is described in the Schedule below.
