**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DAKOTA DRIVE, SOUTHAM) (20 MPH
MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 20-mph speed limit on the length of road described in the Schedule below.

From its junction with Welsh Road East for its entire length, approximately 110 metres.

Beaufort Crescent, Southam

From its junction with Dakota Drive for its entire length, approximately 135 metres.
