ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14(1)

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B4117 HIGH STREET, B4114
BLYTHE ROAD/BIRMINGHAM ROAD, COLESHILL)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026**

WHEREAS the Warwickshire County Council ("the Council") as traffic authority for B4117 High Street, B4114 Blythe Road/Birmingham Road, Coleshill is satisfied that traffic on the said roads should be restricted by virtue of works proposed to be executed thereon or near to.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This order shall come into operation on 27 July 2026 and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (B4117 High Street, B4114 Blythe Road/Birmingham Road, Coleshill) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2026".
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than an exempted vehicle to use B4117 High Street, B4114 Blythe Road/Birmingham Road, Coleshill between the junctions with the B4114 Blythe Road/Birmingham Road and Maxstoke Lane for a period of 18 months commencing on 27 July 2026, or until the said works are completed, whichever is the earlier.
3. In this Order exempted vehicle means any vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
4. While the provisions of Article 2 are in progress the prohibition of Right Turns at the crossroads junction High Street, B4114 Blythe Road/Birmingham Road, Coleshill will be temporarily suspended.
5. The provisions of Articles 2 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs, as authorised by Section 64 of the said Act of 1984.
