**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF NUNEATON & BEDWORTH)
(CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND
RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION)
(VARIATION NO. 6) ORDER 2026**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough Of Nuneaton and Bedworth) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places And Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (as varied), by:

- introducing parking places for disabled badge holders only, as described at the locations in Schedule 1 below; and
- changing the use of parking places from disabled badge holders only to limited waiting / permit holders, as described at the locations in Schedule 2 below.

SCHEDULE 1

Proposed Implementation Blue Badge Holders Only Parking Bays-

1. 9 Anker Street, Nuneaton:

- South-east side of Anker Street, from a point 75 metres north-east of its junction with Attleborough Road (B4114), north-eastwards for a distance of 6.6 metres.

2. 31 Anker Street, Nuneaton:

- South-east side of Anker Street, from a point 30 metres north-east of its junction with Attleborough Road (B4114), north-eastwards for a distance of 6.6 metres.

3. 104 Heath End Road, Nuneaton:

- South side of Heath End Road (B4112), from a point approximately 80 metres east of its junction with Orkney Close, eastwards for a distance of 6.6 metres.

4. 146 Heath End Road, Nuneaton:

- South side of Heath End Road (B4112), from a point approximately 175 metres east of its junction with Orkney Close, eastwards for a distance of 6.6 metres.

5. 124 Norman Avenue:

- East Side of Norman Avenue from a point approximately 32 metres south of its junction with Prince's Avenue, southwards for a distance of 6.6 metres.

1. Glebe Road, Nuneaton:
