ADVANCE WORKS NOTICE

Re **B4455 Fosseway near Princethorpe – New highway works**

As part of Warwickshire County Council's highways maintenance programme, the Council is working in partnership with Balfour Beatty Living Places to invest in and maintain the local highway network.

We are writing to inform you about new highway works planned in your area.

Location and duration

The works will take place on B4455 Fosseway near Princethorpe, from the river bridge near Barn Lane to A423 Oxford Road. The current surface will be removed and replaced, work is planned to start on **10/08/26** and are expected to take approximately **12 days** to complete. There is no weekend work planned but will be undertaken if the need arises.

Works will be delivered using a nighttime road closure and traffic light control during the day. The nighttime working hours are between **20:00 to 06:00**.

What are the new works

New works involve the construction or installation of new highway assets or improvements. This may include new road features, junction improvements, footways, cycle infrastructure, safety enhancements or other upgrades to the highway environment.

These works are being delivered to:

- Improve safety for all road users
- Support better traffic flow and accessibility
- Enhance the condition and functionality of the highway
- Deliver long term improvements for the local area

What to expect

During the works:

- Access to properties will be maintained where possible, although there may be periods of delay or temporary restriction
- Refuse collections will continue as normal, although minor adjustments may be required
- On street parking is likely to be restricted within the works area
- There may be noise, dust and activity from construction vehicles and equipment

We will make every effort to minimise disruption and keep residents informed throughout the works.

What residents need to do

- Avoid parking where no waiting cones are in place
- Move vehicles away from the works area in advance
- Follow temporary traffic management and site signage
- Keep children and pets away from the site and construction equipment
