ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14(1)

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B4455 FOSSE WAY,
PRINCETHORPE/EATHORPE)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) AND (TEMPORARY 40MPH SPEED
RESTRICTION) ORDER 2026**

WHEREAS the Warwickshire County Council ("the Council") as traffic authority for B4455 Fosse Way, Princethorpe/Eathorpe is satisfied that traffic on the said road should be restricted by virtue of works proposed to be executed thereon.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This order shall come into operation on 10 August 2026 and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (B4455 Fosse Way, Princethorpe/Eathorpe) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2026".
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than an exempted vehicle to use B4455 Fosse Way, Princethorpe/Eathorpe between its junctions with the A423 Oxford Road and Penns Lane for a period of 18 months commencing on 10 August 2026, or until the said works are completed, whichever is the earlier.
3. In this Order exempted vehicle means any vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour from existing 40 mph (at Princethorpe Nameplate) to Penns Lane for a period of 18 months commencing on 10 August 2026, or until the said works are completed, whichever is the earlier.
5. The provisions of Articles 2 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs, as authorised by Section 64 of the said Act of 1984.
