ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, HONINGTON,
STRATFORD-UPON-AVON)
(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 30 mph speed limit on the length of road described in the Schedule below. **The Order will commence on 10th August 2026.**

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE
(30mph speed limit)

D6639 Fell Mill Lane

From its junction with Idlicote Road southeast for 188 metres.

D6632 Granby Road

From its junction with Idlicote Road north for 310 metres.

D6637 Honington Hall Road

In its entirety from its junction with Idlicote Road.

C53 Idlicote Road

From a point 94 metres southwest of its junction with Honington Hall Road in a northeast and then an easterly direction, to a point 71 metres northeast of its junction with Granby Road (being a length of approximately 610 metres).

D6638 Vicarage Road

In its entirety from its junction with Honington Hall Road.
