ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, LEAMINGTON SPA) (20 MPH
SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to introduce a 20 mph speed limit on the roads Admiral Way, Badgers Retreat, Beavers Brook, Brimstone End, Burgundy Gardens, Chalkhill Place, Chesterton Drive, Emperor Boulevard, Grayling Crescent, Hastang Fields, Horsepool Hollow, Kingfishers Reach, Littleworth Croft, Marbled Close, Mill Pond Meadows, Otters Rest, Parish End, Pebble Island Way, Redhill Furrows, St Fremund Way, Peacock Close and Withy Bank in varying lengths as per the Order's Schedule. The Order commences on 01 September 2026.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
