ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BRIDGE END, WARWICK)
(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20 mile per hour speed limit on the roads mentioned in the Schedule below. **The order commences on 21st September 2026.**

A copy of the made Order, together with a plan showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick during usual opening hours, or online at <https://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/news/20210/warwick-district>.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The entire length of Bridge End from its junctions with Banbury Road.

Brooke Close, Warwick

The entire length of Brooke Close, Warwick, from its junction with Bridge End.

Archery Fields, Warwick

The entire length of Archery Fields, Warwick, from its junction with Bridge End.

The Templars, Warwick

The entire length of The Templars, Warwick, from its junction with Bridge End.
