**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A4189 WARWICK – HENLEY-IN-ARDEN –
REDDITCH ROAD AND LYE GREEN ROAD, CLAVERDON)
(30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (VARIATION NO. 2) ORDER 2026; AND**

**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DISTRICT OF STRATFORD
ON AVON) (SPEED LIMIT) (A4189 CLAVERDON VARIATION NO. 3) ORDER 2026**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above-named Orders, the effect of which is to extend a 40 mph speed limit, replacing a section of existing 50 mph speed limit, on the A4189 Station Road, Claverdon. The additional extent of 40 mph speed limit is described in the Schedule below. The Order commences on Monday 21 September 2026.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Orders apply to the High Court for this purpose.

From a point 35 metres east of its junction with Wheelbarrow Lane, eastwards for a distance of 1027 metres.
