

WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCILROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(HAMPTON ROAD AND OLD SCHOOL LANE, HAMPTON-ON-THE-HILL)
(RESTRICTED ROADS) ORDER, 2001

The Warwickshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of the Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Each of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
2. This Order may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (Hampton Road and Old School Lane, Hampton-on-the-Hill) (Restricted Roads) Order 2001" and shall come into operation on the 9th April 2001.

SCHEDULE

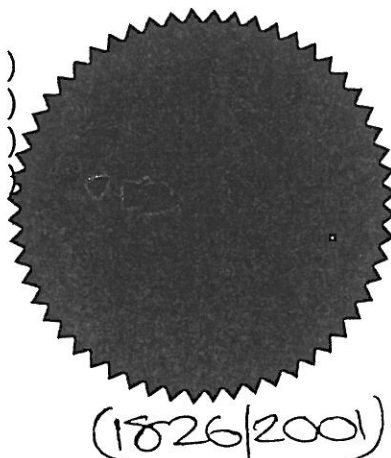
Lengths of road at Hampton-on-the-Hill in the Parish of Budbrooke.

1. Hampton Road
From its junction with Old School Lane eastwards for 75 metres.
2. Old School Road
From its junction with the A4189 Warwick-Henley-in-Arden-Redditch road northwards for 63 metres.
