Making your Application

- A Notice of Application for Modification order, **(Form A)**

Your completed application form, should then be returned to the County Council with:

- an Ordnance Survey plan of the route
- a certificate of Notice of Application for Modification Order, **(Form B)** listing the owners/occupiers to whom you sent a copy of **(Form A)**.
- Evidence – documents, photographs, "Witness Statement" forms **(Form G)**

- 1) Little Packington Enclosure Award (Q575/13) 1824: this award also apportioned tithes over whole of parish and shows lane for whole length coloured, as all other roads in parish, and not numbered since not subject to tithes. Includes two items which refer to lane:-
item 121 (waste land) which has, on south "the said lane leading from the said Packington Bridge to the Hermitage Farm"
item 122 which has, on north: "the said lane leading from the said Packington Bridge to the Hermitage Farm"
- 2) Estate map of Hermitage Farm (Z580(L)/3) 1776 & shows route coloured with area of 1a 2r 36p which is listed in schedule as "lanes and bridle road through the estate" and described as "waste" with map showing road as coming "from Packington Bridge"
- 3) west part shown on 'list of streets' (E534)
- 4) undated plan on planning application file NW33, prepared by County Council and next to draft decision dated 20/1/56: shows road network in area and includes west part of this route to point north of north-west corner of Twists Wood (i.e. further east than shown on current map of 'list of streets' and subsequently quarried for gravel.
- 5) no highway closure orders (or diversion orders) exist for this route although London Gazette advertisements have been thoroughly checked as well as all other records (including Quarter Sessions)

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
