

ON SPLANE STARTS OFF THE COUNTY ROAD C127 AT COPSTON MAGNA, DOWN GREEN LANE AN UNCLASSIFIED COUNTY ROAD AND CONTINUES IN A SOUTH EASTERLY DIRECTION TO ISS JUNCTION WITH THE FOSSE WAY THE B4455 AT CLOUDESLEY BUSH. IT IS SOME 2 RILOMETRES LONG AND THE SURFACE IS OF PADDIED GRASS. THIS VARIES FROM 3 TO 4 METRES WIDE IN PAHCES TO 10-20 METRES IN OTHERS. THERE ARE ITED BES ON BOTH SIDES SOME OVERBROWN IN PLITCES, AND HEDGES ON ONE SIDE ONLY IN OTHERS, ALSO THE IS A GATE HT APPROX; GIRN REF: 4550-9775.
