I hereby apply for an Order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Warwick by Upgrading -

R267 LEAVES THE D2267 OPPOSITE THE SITE OF THE MEDIEVAL VILLARE OF CALDCOTE THEN OVER THE RAILWAY LINE (DISMANTLED) WITH VENTNOR FARM ON THE RIGHT AND CONTINUES TO THE TURN OFF TO CALCUTT HOUSE FARM ON THE LEFT. PASSING CALCUTT SPINNEY ON THE RIGHT AND ONTO THE D2299 AND A425 AT LOWER SHUCKBURGH.


