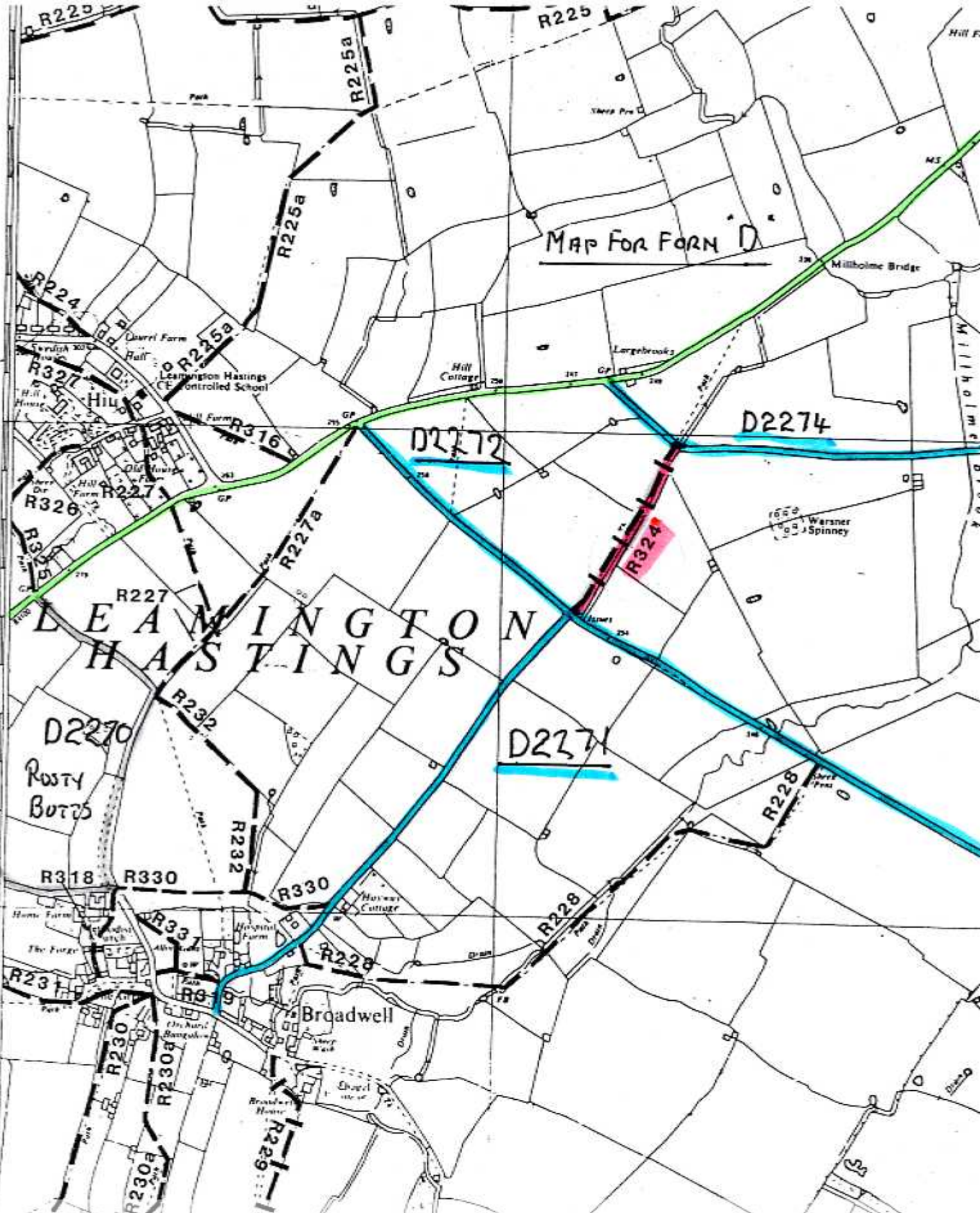
DOCUMENTS. 1 PROPOSE TURNPIKE ROAD 1809 REF: Q5111/15.

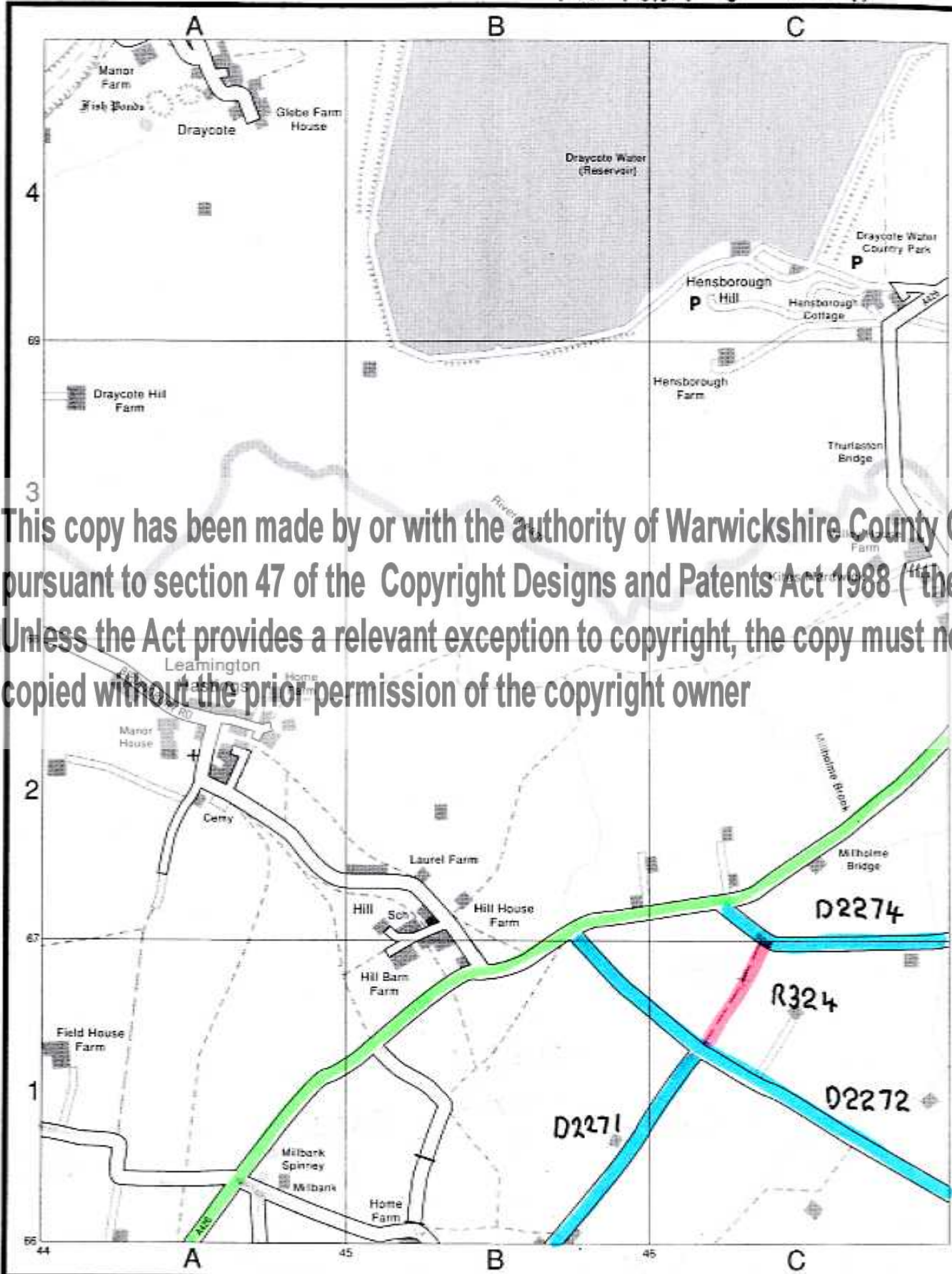
3 THE APPORTINMENTS REF: CR 569/156 1844  
A MAP OF THE PARISH OF LEAMINGTON HASTINGS 1834.  
R324 IS THE NORTHERN PART OF BIG GROUND LANE. THE BROADWELL TO KITES GREEN ROAD AT THIS NORTHERN END. IT TURNS NORTHWEST AND IS NOW PART OF THE GRANDBOROUGH TO SOUTHAM ROAD NOW THE A426. IT IS MARKED BECCARS REST LANE. THE WHOLE OF THE BIG GROUND LANE INCLUDING R324 IS SHOWN IN PARTS ENCLOSED.
