I hereby apply for an Order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Warwick by Upgrading -

> from a Public Footpath / Bridleway*

to a Public bridleway / Byway open to all traffic* *delete as appropriate

Description: THE ROUTE STARTS AT THE D2066 CATHINON LANE WITH A STONY TRACK LEADING TO THE CANAL BRIDGE SOME SFEET WIDE AT THIS POINT. IT THEN RUNS UNDER THE RAILWAY BRIDGE AND THROUGH A WOODED FRED CATHIRON SPINNEYS TO A GATE . IT THEN WIDENS UPINTO A PADDOCK TYPE AREA TO A SECOND BATE. WITCH OPENS UP TO A ROFOOT WIDE STUNY TRACK PAST LILIC COTTACE ONTO THE CIRY EASENHALL RURD NEAD TO THE JUNCTION WITH THE DZOGS. TOTAL LENCTH SOME 1 TO 1.5 MILES LONG. ALSO SEE ENCLOSED PHOTOGRAPHS.


