Information for Referrers, Parents and Carers

Entrust Care Partnership is a not for profit organisation operating in Warwickshire, supporting disabled children, young people, young adults and their parents/carers.

The Open Door Café is a part of St Michaels Church in Budbrooke, Hampton Magna. The vision of their not-forprofit charity café is to reach out to and serve the local community in a way which is consistent with Christian values and which provides for Christian mission.

Following on from our successful Entrust Entrepreneur sessions, we have developed a partnership to offer Day Opportunities for young people and young adults who have disabilities.

Through the opportunity our Entrust Entrepreneurs will support in all aspects of the daily running of the Café, working towards in – house and accredited training, alongside developing their entrepreneurial skills in craft and cooking.

We are offering 6 places a day, initially on Wednesday and Thursday, with the opportunity to develop to 4 days.

The Entrust Entrepreneurs will be supported by a Manager from the Café, Manager from Entrust Care Partnership and Entrust Care Partners and Volunteers.
