

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH M395 IN THE PARISH OF NETHER WHITACRE

Warwickshire County Council <u>made</u> a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

Effect of Order	Public Footpath M395 Nether Whitacre closed to all traffic from its junction with Station Road to a point where the footpath forks in a north/south east direction immediately east of the railway, Grid References SP22007 92378.
Reason for Order	To avoid the likelihood of danger to the public whilst Network Rail works are being carried out on and near to the footpath.

Order Effective from: 2 October 2020 and was due to expire 1 April 2021.

However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has directed that the Order should continue in force until **1 October 2021** or until works are completed, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State issues a further direction).
