**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH R250 IN THE
PARISHES OF WILLOUGHBY & WOLFHAMPCOTE**

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order
details as indicated below:

Effect of Order	Public Footpath R250 in the Parishes of Willoughby & Wolfhampcote closed to all traffic.
Reason for Order	To avoid the likelihood of danger to the public because of the dilapidated and dangerous condition of a bridge along its route
Order Effective from: 10 November 2018 and was due to expire 9 May 2021. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has directed that the Order should continue in force until 10 May 2023 or until remedial works are completed, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State issues a further direction).	
Access & Diversion: An alternative route will be signed and is available via Moor Lane, Willoughby Road and Wolfampcote Lane.
