 COUNTY BOUNDARY AT RAINB BELDOR, AND ON TO THE  
 M45 MIDLAND BRIDGE.  
 THE ROUTE CONSISTS OF A COMBINATION OF BRUCEL,  
 COMPACTED EARTH SOME WITH A GRASS COVER, AND  
 PITTED BRUCE SURFACES THROUGHOUT BETWEEN 3 TO 4 METRE WIDE,
