COUNTY ROAD AND CONTINUES IN A SOUTH EASTERLY
DIRECTION TO ITS JUNCTION WITH THE FOSSE WAY THE
B4455 AT CLOUDESKEY BUSH. IT IS SOME 2 KILOMETRES
LONG AND THE SURFACE IS OF PADDIED GRASS. THIS VARIES
FROM 3 TO 4 METRES WIDE IN PLICES TO 10-20 METRES IN
OTHERS. THERE ARE HEDGES ON BOTH SIDES SOME OVERGROWN
IN PLICES, AND HEDGES ON ONE SIDE ONLY IN OTHERS, ALSO
