That part of R73a from the western end of the county road the D2044 near the railway and the canal bridge at the above grid reference. It then heads in a north easterly direction on a single tarmac track towards Mobbs Wood for some 400 metres. It then continues to the left side of the track along the headland of a ploughed field for a further 100 metres. From Mobbs Wood, it crosses diagonally over a grassed field and onto a narrow fenced path to join R73 at the grid reference above. Total length some 700 metres.
